Em D G D A7 B7 It's not easy facing up when your whole world is black

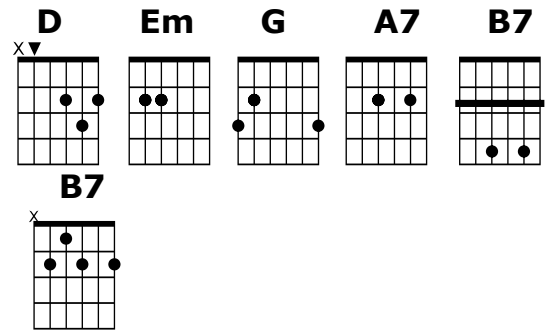
